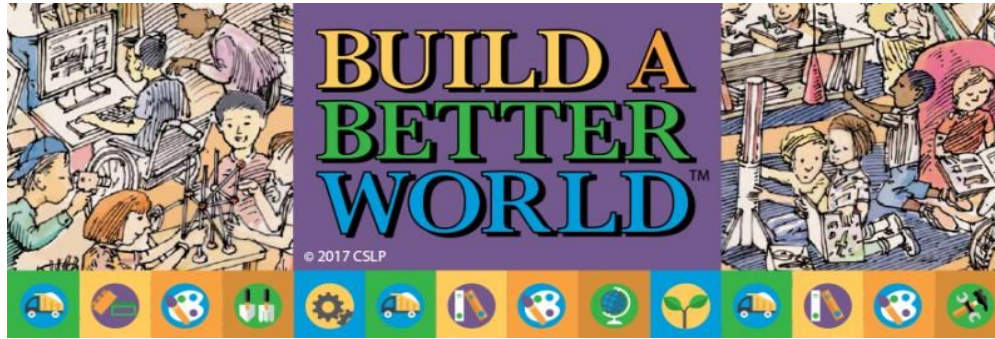

**FAQs about Summer Reading**

- Do I have to register?** No. Unless noted, all programs do not require registration.
- Do we have to attend every class?** No, you can chose which days to come, but please try to stick with your child's age group.
- What ages can come to the special programming?** All ages and family members are welcome at special programming.
- What class should my child attend?** Baby and me is 0-24 months, Preschool is 2-4. For the K-2 and 3-5 class, choose based on the grade your child has completed.
- Can siblings attend each others classes even if they are different ages?** Most of the time, this shouldn't be a problem. Please see the children's librarian for more info

**Why Participate in the Summer Reading Program?**

- The library offers free, fun activities that encourage children to read for fun.
- Young children can lose an average of 2-3 months of learning during the summer.
  - Reading just 5 books over the summer can prevent reading loss!
- Kids who participate in Summer Reading Programs are better prepared for the next school year.
